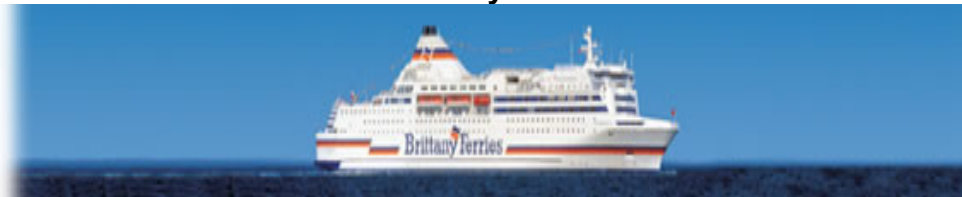

## REGATTA RULES

The committee will not hold itself responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any competitors, other persons, or to boats and equipment.

All events are held under the rules of the Hants and Dorset ARA.

No.1 position to be counted from the starter.

Crews are reminded that the times of the races are provisional and crews must be available when called by the Regatta Controller. Failure to be at the starting point may lead to disqualification. All coxswains must wear BSI lifejackets. Failure to do so WILL lead to disqualification.

In the event of race scratchings the committee reserve the right to amalgamate heat.

NO PARKING IS PERMITTED ON THE GRASS. Limited parking is available within the park but priority will be given to boat trailers. On the road parking is available along the main road by the park and off some side roads. Drivers must not hassle the parking attendants.

Crews must be on the water no later than 5 minutes before the race start

Once the Regatta race has started, no crews are allowed on the course, unless involved in a race in progress.

Senior Mens & Ladies Finals are twice around the course (indicated \*)

Spectators must not congregate within the roped areas surrounding the officials starting area.

In the interests of safety, emergency procedures must be adhered to all times.

All J16 must be under 16 and novice status

## SAFETY, EMERGENCY PLAN AND COMMUNICATION INFORMATION

In an emergency contact the Regatta control & one of the following, indicate the type of emergency and assistance required:

### Telephones

Public telephones are situated throughout the park and shown by the letter 'T' on the enclosed map. There will be an emergency mobile phone at the Regatta Control. Club Captains must ensure they confirm the number on the day.

### Rescue Boats

Rescue boats will be provided. They will carry two way radios, ARA Rescue & Safety kit and will be manned by RYA crew.

### Radio Networks and Communications

Radio contact will be available between Regatta Control, the Starters, the Umpires and the Rescue Boats with a spare radio set held at the Regatta

Control. The PA system will cover the area between Regatta Control and the Boat Pound. Starters and Umpires will have loud hailer.

### First Aid Cover

A first aid tent will be available and Dorset safety kits will be carried in the Rescue Boats and are available at the Starters, Regatta Control and the Umpires.. Please take time to familiarise yourself with these locations.

### Reporting of Accidents

Please report any accident occurring on the day to the Regatta Control for entry into the accident book held there. When reporting any incident, give your name, location, current situation, action required and do not leave your calling position unless asked.

### Emergencies Afloat

Crews in difficulties should stay in or with their boat and await arrival of the Rescue Boat. Ensure you follow any instructions from the Rescue boat including landings.

### Emergency Telephone Calls

For AMBULANCE, COASTGUARD, FIRE or POLICE – In an emergency dial 999 and ask for the service you require, stating your name, the number of the phone you are using, its location and details of the incident

Poole Hospital (Longfleet Road) is equipped with full Accident and Emergency facilities and is situated across the main road alongside the park at the town centre end of the park. Dial 999.

## Toilets:

The are toilets near the road at the corner of the park behind the children's play area and at the main café Jungle Jims. Please ensure you leave them as you would wish to find them—thank you.

## EMERGENCY PLAN (see map and other instructions inside)

In the event of an emergency during the Regatta, the emergency / rescue services will co-ordinated from the Regatta Control, which is located near the start line (see map).

The Regatta control will have direct Radio contact with the Safety boat, on site Ambulance, all Regatta Officials, competitors and spectators via the P.A system. A Mobile phone will also be available for calls to the Emergency services.

The Regatta controller will co-ordinate all the rescue, in his absence the senior Hants & Dorset Official will act on his behalf and take control.

The Regatta will be suspended, if the Regatta Controller, following consultation with the Regatta Secretary, Emergency Services and Racing Officials deem this necessary.

**The first aid tent or Ambulance will be located in the same place within the Regatta area.**

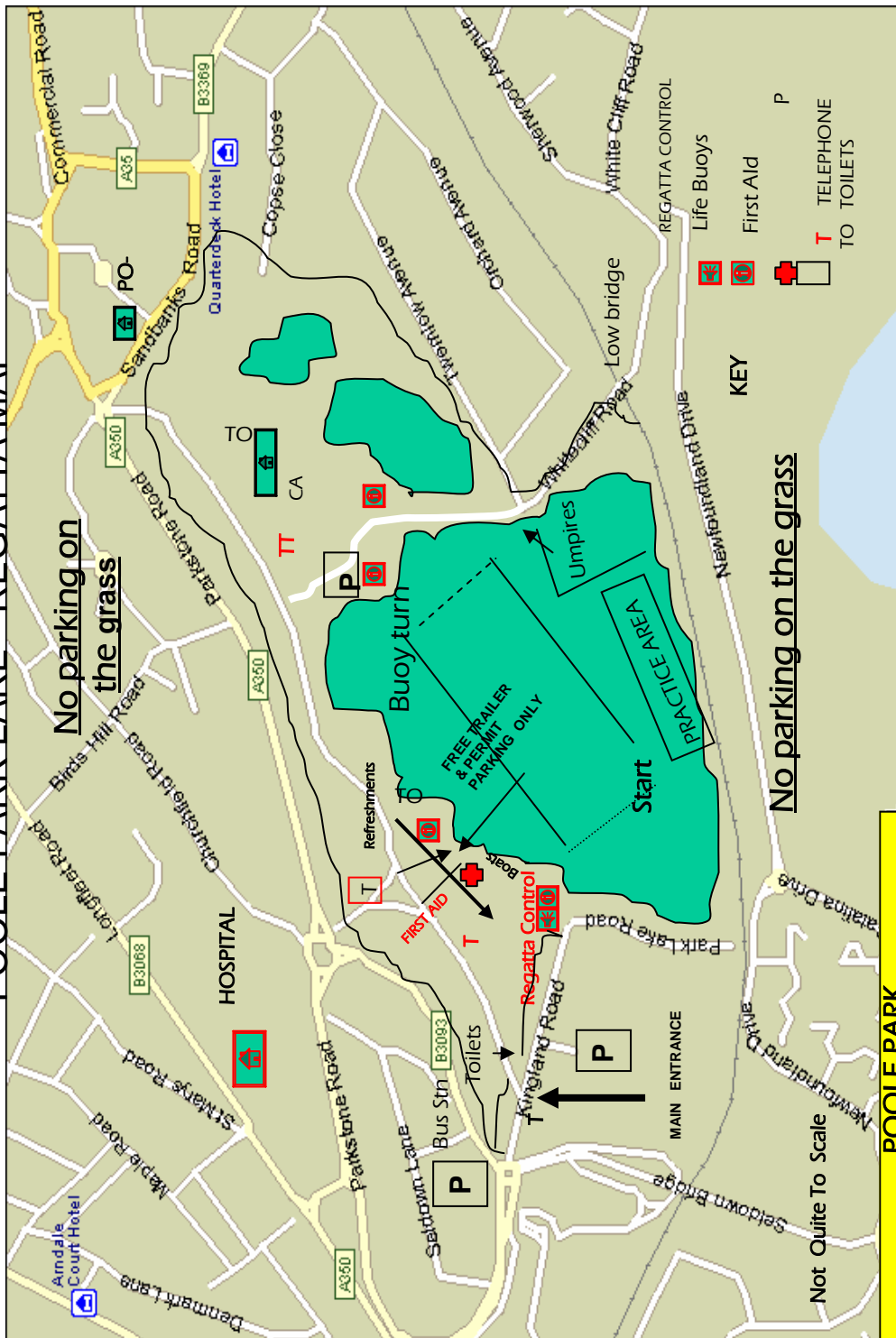
